Educational Psychology doctoral students are eligible to apply for graduate assistantships and tuition scholarship. Graduate assistantships provide students with the opportunity to assist faculty members with research, teaching, and similar academic responsibilities. Graduate assistants typically work 15-20 hours per week, receive a stipend, and tuition remission (i.e., scholarship). In some cases, part-time graduate assistantships may be available (i.e., 5 -14 hours per week). Tuition scholarship is available for students with or without a graduate assistantship.
