Career and Professional Development (CPD) has launched the new [Office of Student Employment](#) (OSE).

Led by Julie Veselka, director of student employment, OSE now serves as a one-stop shop for Baylor students' employment opportunities both on- and off-campus. OSE also is launching new student employment software to assist with effectively managing job postings and applications. This streamlined program will not only be easier for students to navigate employment opportunities but also has the added benefit of being a direct part of [Career and Professional Development](#), providing numerous career resources for students' success beyond Baylor.

More than a year of planning and development has gone into the newly formed department. Previously, student employment processes were divided between Student Financial Aid and Human Resources. In order to both provide a better service to students and to ensure proper record keeping, the student employment functions have been consolidated into one office creating a complete job center for students, including part-time student jobs, internships and post-graduation employment.

OSE also oversees the University Internship Program and will assist students in finding and preparing for internships, which are a significant experiential learning opportunity for students. Internships allow them to gain experience in the workplace by providing the opportunity for skill development in preparation for a post-graduation job.

Employment on-campus has been shown to improve school performance through job structure and responsibility. With faculty and staff involvement, students build a stronger community and network, and they gain valuable job skills and real-world experience that directly transfers to employment after graduation. On-campus employment assists in lowering educational expenses through the Federal Work-Study Program and earning potential.
