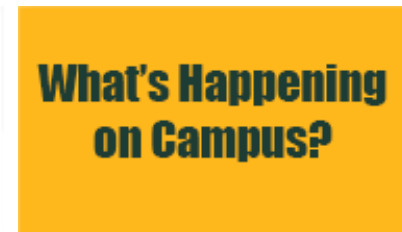
Bound for the Brave 5K/10K Run
