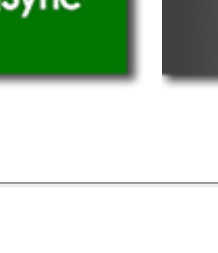
Waco Downtown Farmers Market

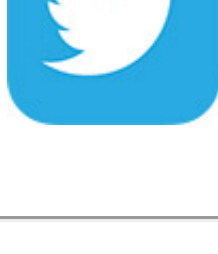
Heart of Texas Airshow
