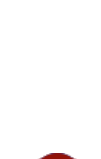

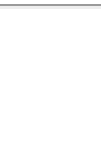

Traditions Rally



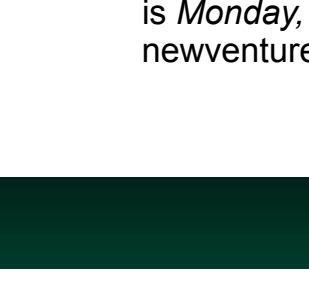
