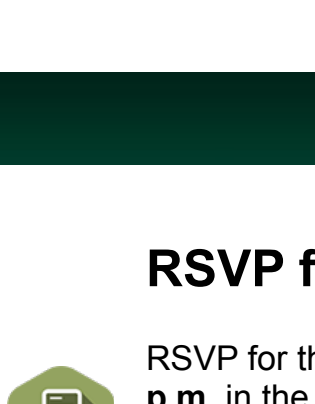

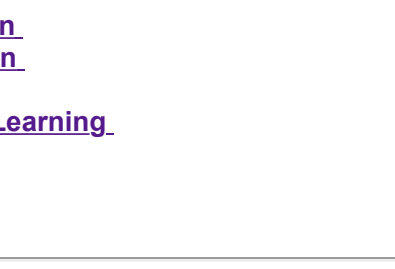
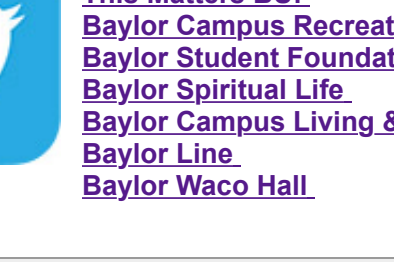
John James Audubon: Life, Work, Legacy

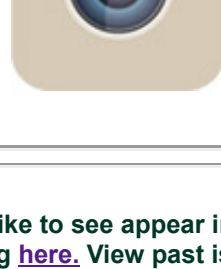
Out of Darkness Community Walk

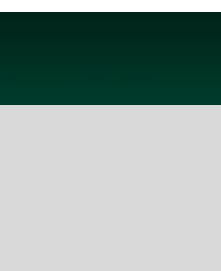
