Central Texas Astronomical Society Observatory Open House

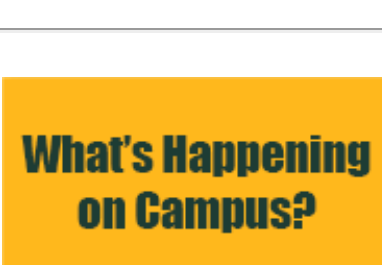

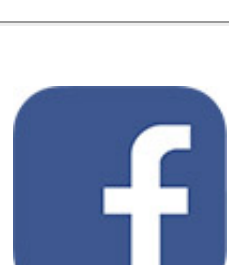
