### Donuts and Dialogue - Men in Mental Health



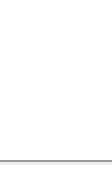

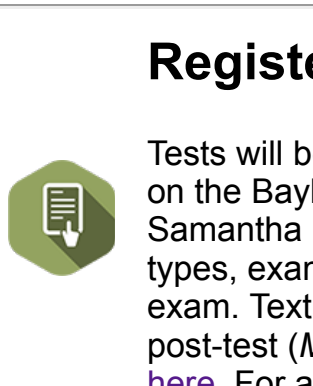
