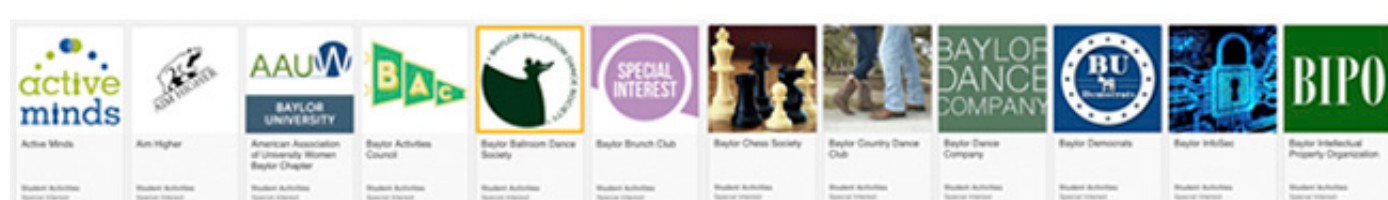

2019-2020 Student Regent Selection Process



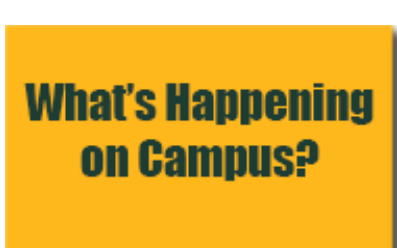
