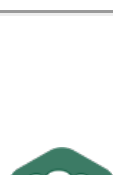

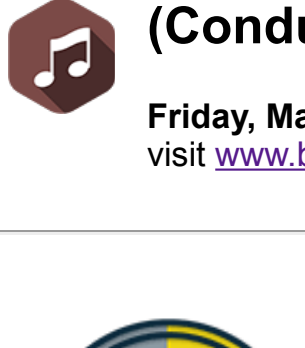

Painting Stories

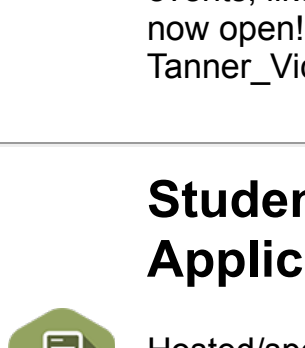
