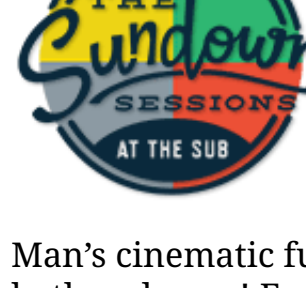

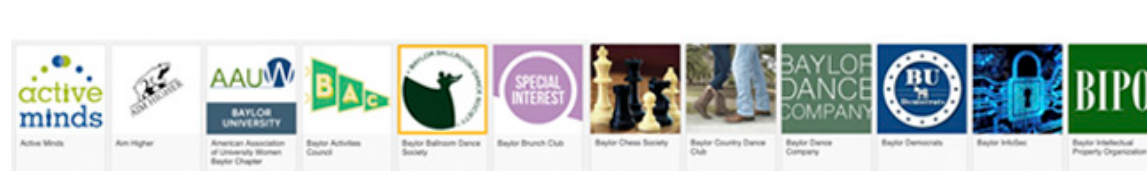
Waco Downtown Farmer's Market

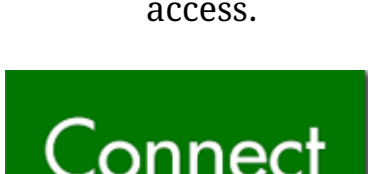
