Seek—it is yourself.

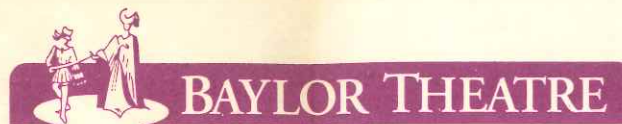
