Application Guidelines

PURPOSE: This endowed scholarship is intended to help defray the cost of seminary education for eligible currently-enrolled students at George W. Truett Theological Seminary.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must

- Be a second year or third year masters student
- Have completed OR are currently registered for Hebrew and Greek
- Be seeking to pastor a church upon graduation (current pastors are eligible)
- Be in good standing with 2.0 minimum GPA

AWARD DETAILS: Up to two awards will be given per year. The award is for general educational use and is not restricted to tuition. While it is anticipated that the award amount is \$1750 per recipient per year to pay within the spring semester, final award amounts and timing will depend upon (1) funds generated in the corpus of the original gift and, (2) decisions by the Truett faculty award committee.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Applicants should review the guidelines and access the application form available on the Current Student Additional Scholarships webpage on the Truett website. Each applicant must submit a completed hard-copy application to the Scholarship Services Office in person or by mail **by December 1**st.

AWARD NOTIFICATION & PROCESS: Recipients and non-recipients will be notified by email upon the committee's final determination and awards will be processed via the student's account at Baylor University.
