

Baylor's Truett Seminary Partnership Scholarships

Partnership Scholarships present an opportunity for the church family of a Truett Seminary student to support that student's calling by investing in his or her theological education. Though Truett awards significant scholarships, these funds are limited to tuition and may not cover tuition in full. A few of the outstanding expenses a Truett student may incur include:

\$340	Vehicle Permit (optional per year)
\$500	Books and Supplies (estimated per semester)
\$1,500	Student Fees (estimated per semester)
\$6,300	Tuition (estimated per semester) <i>A student's final tuition rate is dependent upon scholarships received and the number of course hours taken; the \$6,300 estimate is based on a 12-hour course load and no Baptist scholarship)</i>
